by Budapest Vandor Choir and its sponsors, the Association of Friends of Budapest Vandor Choir and the Foundation in memory of the choir's great conductors Sandor Vandor and Laszlo Revesz.

Come and see the historical city of Budapest: the monumental Chain Bridge, the imposing Parliament, the Hero's Square. Experience our thermal springs and spas, take a Danube course, try some traditional Hungarian food... but of course, most of

all, sing with us, show us how good you are - here in Hungary one of the homelands of choral music.

Our competition offers a unique chance of equality: the categories of the competition are based on the number of professional (professional, who has a musical degree or studying music) musicians of the choir.

Come and sing with us here in Budapest!



AWARDING SYSTEM

Contestants receive a certification of merit, or may be awarded with a golden, silver or bronze certificate based on scores received:

Highest score available: 90 points

Golden Certificate: 75-90 points

Silver Certificate: 60-74 points

Bronze Certificate: 45-59 points

Prizes in both categories:

I. 150.000 HUF

II. 120.000 HUF

III. 80.000 HUF

Conductor Prize

Jury may decide to hand out a special award to one of the choir conductors (this person does not need to be the conductor of a prize or award winning choir).



RULES AND REGULATIONS

ELIGIBILITY

Standard Category: At least 75% of the choir's singers are amateurs, i.e. they neither have a certificate, nor are they following undergraduate/graduate studies for music, except for the conductor, soloists and accompanists.

Professional Category: More than 25% of the singers have a musical degree, or following studies for music.

The jury may recategorize applicants based on the audial material, in which case the choir either accepts it or may get full refund and leave the event.

REPERTOIRE REQUIREMENTS FOR FESTIVAL

Secular programme of 20 minutes and/or religious programme of 8 minutes (max 2 pieces). The number of singers and composition of the choir are not restricted. Organisers will choose one piece of the repertoire to be performed during the opening concert or the gala concert.

REPERTOIRE REQUIREMENTS FOR COMPETITION

At least one contemporary (no older than 15 years) choral is required from the choir's country of origin. At least two more contrasting pieces of the choir's own choice, of different characters and different musical era.

Total Length of the programme: 12-15 minutes singing.

Instrumental accompaniment is allowed to max 1 piece, of max 3 instruments.

An English translation is required for pieces not written in Latin, English, Italian, German or Hungarian.

Applications without copyrighted scores will have to be rejected. Using non-copyright material during the contest will result in

exclusion from the competition. The programme cannot be changed after the scores have arrived.

REGISTRATION FEE AND CONDITIONS

Registration fee: 50 Euro/choir, payment is due together with the application form, non-refundable (except in case the choir cannot accept the jury's recategorization).

Participation fee for the Festival: 100 Euro/choir

Participation fee for the Competition: 300 Euro/ choir

Competing choirs are eligible to participate in non-competitive activities without an additional fee.

Registration fee is part of the participation fee if the registration is accepted.

Booking and financing travel costs and accommodation are the participants' responsibility.

REFUND

50% refund possible upon cancellation between 2nd and 15th April 2020

25% refund possible upon cancellation between 16th and 30th April 2020

0% refund possible upon cancellation after 30th April 2020

Refund rules do not apply to the registration fee!

DAY 1 – THURSDAY 14 MAY, 2020 19:00

OPENING GALA CONCERT

Conductors, jury, sponsors, and representatives of the local government greet the audience then an Opening Gala Concert starts the 4-day event. Performing choirs are chosen and informed beforehand by the Jury. After the concert, conductors and singers of the different choirs get the opportunity to meet and greet each other.

DAY 2 - FRIDAY 15 MAY, 2020

ACOUSTIC REHEARSALS AND COMPETITION

Contestants will be scheduled to rehearse on the spot from 10:00 AM. The competition will start at 14:00 PM.

DAY 3 – SATURDAY 16 MAY, 2020

OPEN AIR CONCERT IN THE MORNING, CHURCH CONCERT IN THE EVENING

Festival participants will give an open-air concert in the morning. A concert of sacred music will also be given at the local Catholic church (Árpád-házi Szent Erzsébet templom) at the Square of Roses (Rózsák tere) at 7:00 PM.

DAY 4 – SUNDAY 17 MAY, 2020

CLOSING CEREMONY AND GALA CONCERT

A Gala Concert with the best performers of the Event will close the Festival and Competition with the announcement of the competition results. The Jury presents the awards and certificates.

*In case of a large number of applicants, organizers may change scheduling of the days of the contest and acoustic repetition. Organizers will inform the choirs accordingly in advance.
